We recognize that your funding for this has almost disappeared, and we will gladly provide engineering and duplicating services at no charge to you. puring our discussions, we agreed on the following points: 1. You will provide the audio tapes required for each weekly program, the first being either January 18 or 25. 2. Our assistance will continue until June 30, 1984, but we will evaluate our cooperation on March 31, 1984, in order to make whatever adjustments are necessary. You indicate to us that about five hours of engineering time is required each week. We will be flexible in making additional hours available to you as required. 4. Ed Becker of ECC will be the Recording Engineer. However, if Mr. Becker is not available on a particular day, then you and Al Oickle would arrange for the recording to be made at WUSB instead. 5. You will attempt to provide a student back-up for Mr. Becker and pay for that student's services. Please get back to me as soon as you can and let me know what luck you have.
