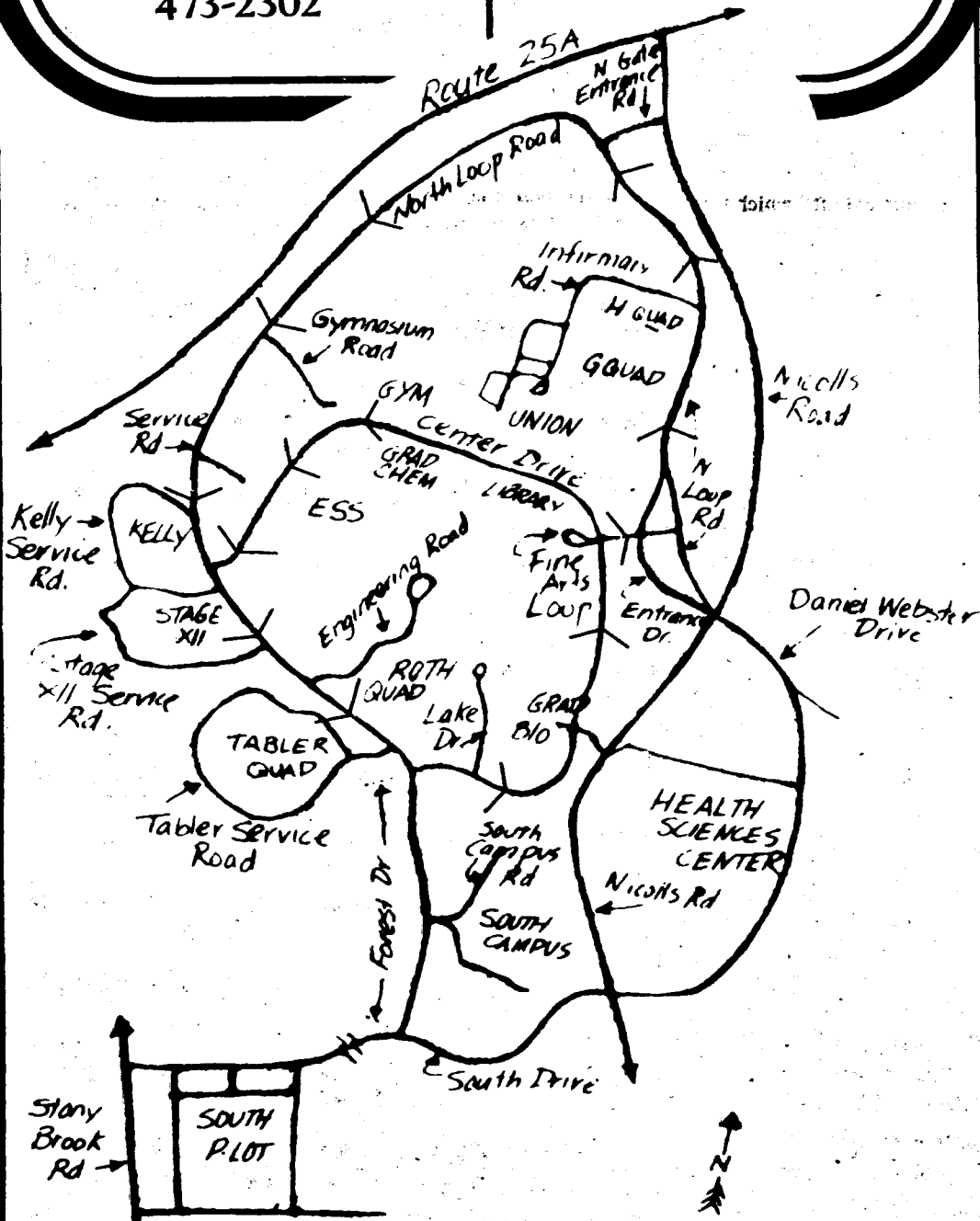

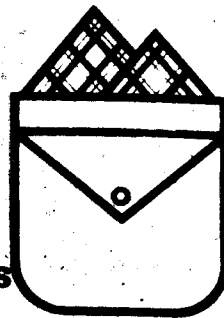
The route of the 6.214 mile University run:
