It is with mixed emotions that I write to inform you that David Conover, Dean of the School of Marine and Atmospheric Sciences, has accepted a position as the Director of the Division of Ocean Sciences with the National Science Foundation. I am, as I am sure many of you are, sad to see David leave the position as Dean of SoMAS after serving with such distinction in this capacity for the past seven years. David will remain a faculty member with SoMAS during his service to the NSF.

I am proud David has accepted this Directorship with the NSF, effective July 2010. This appointment is the lead position in Ocean Sciences, which is the largest division at NSF.
