

UUP 403(b) TAX DEFERRED ANNUITY

For your information you will find a list in the UUP Office of the vision care panel practitioners. You must first contact the Vision Care Plan at 1-800-828-6100 as instructed in the green brochure that was sent to you in August. The Vision Care Plan will then send you a voucher and you can go to a panel practitioner of your choice.

This voucher entitles you to an eye exam and to select from a large assortment of stylish "Plan" frames. There is no copayment on deductible charges and no cash outlay, except for special lenses, contact lenses or special non-plan materials where you pay the difference. If you select a non-plan practitioner, there is a schedule of allowances.

PLEASE read all the information in the voucher package. This benefit can only be used once every 24 months and there is a time limit on the voucher. For more information contact the UUP Office at 444-1505.
