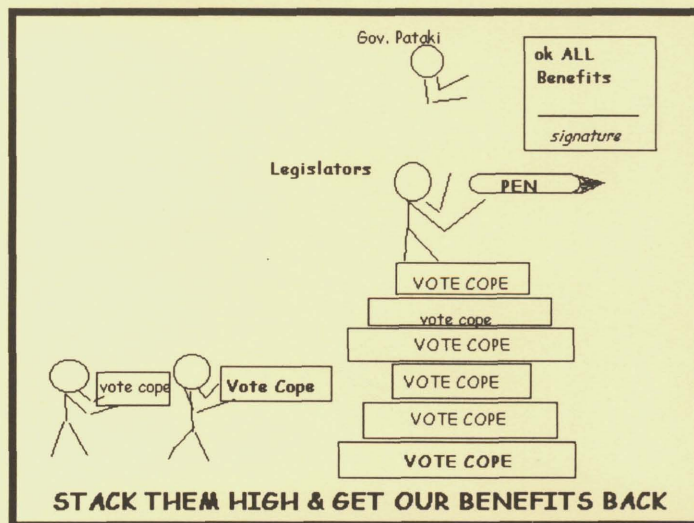
VOTE/COPE
