PRESCRIPTION DRUG CARD

There has been some questions among the members of the UUP as to where is "my" Prescription Card, and what if my druggist won't accept my NPA card where do I go or what should I do for reimbursement?

The answer to the first question of why I did not get my Prescription Card is that the enrollment card (if you are a new employee) may have been lost or misplaced while being sent to the Public Employees Benefit Fund. This can be solved by filling out another card, which can be obtained in the UUP Office on the 2nd level of the HSC, Room 167. If you have moved, call the PEBF Office, 800-522-7002 to give them your new address so you will get a card next year.

There are two (2) solutions to the "what if my druggist won't accept my NPA card"?

One, you might have your druggist call NPA (toll free at 800-526-7813) to inquire about joining the NPA panel of druggists.

Two, you pay for the prescription and submit a green NPA direct-reimbursement form to your druggist to fill out and then you forward it to NPA for reimbursement. (Forms may be obtained from the UUP office)
CAUTION:::You will be paid an amount no greater than the amount paid to your druggist (if your druggist charges above usual, customary and reasonable charge (UCR) for the drug ingredient cost, you will only be reimbursed for the UCR amount minus the \$2 co-pay). These vouchers must be submitted within 45 days of the date of the prescription purchase in order for you to be reimbursed.

A list of druggists for the four counties is available and kept in the UUP Office, L2 - Room 167.

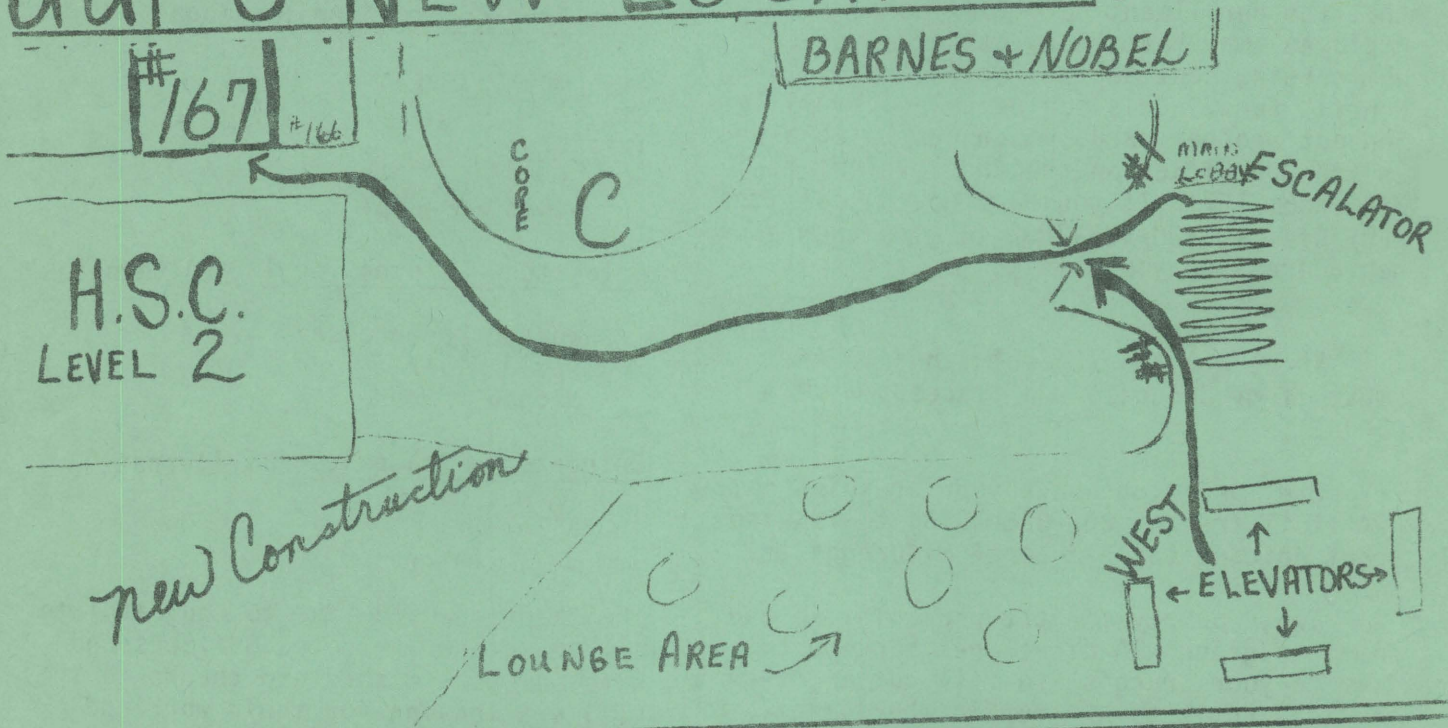

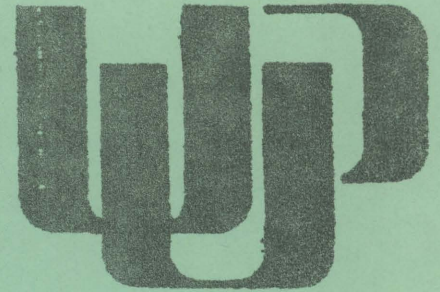

Payroll Deduction Authority for UUP Membership
TO THE COMPTROLLER OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK

I am a member of or apply herein for membership in United University Professions of the State University of New York, and HEREBY AUTHORIZE YOU to deduct from my salary and to pay over to United University Professions or a branch, base the amount of \$_____ to pay for my dues in said organization. Such authorization is made in accordance with the provisions of Section 6a of the Finance Law. You are further authorized to make any adjustments in said deduction as may be certified to you from time to time by UUP. I hereby authorize the United University Professions to act as my exclusive representative for the purposes of collective bargaining and in the administration of grievances. I understand that this office may be revoked at any time by written notice to you to discontinue deductions for membership dues.

Annual membership dues in United University Professions are one percent of employee's basic annual salary for employees at or above the minimum salary negotiated for the bargaining unit; five tenths of one percent for employees below the minimum salary negotiated for the bargaining unit, to a maximum of \$450. Biweekly UUP dues deduction can be computed by dividing total yearly UUP dues by 21 or 26 depending on employee's schedule.
