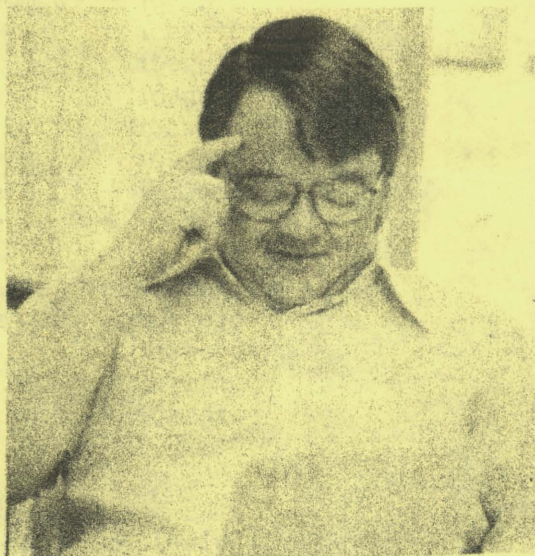

HARTNETT RE-ELECTED

James Hartnett was re-elected as President of the HSC Chapter of the United University Professions in the April balloting. Members returned 167 ballots before the 5 pm deadline on April 17, 1981. Twenty-one ballots were ineligible for tabulation due to the lack of a validating signature on the return envelope.

Academics chose Henry Godfrey, who ran unopposed, as their vice-president. Sarah Gudaitis, from the Pharmacology Department, was newly elected to the position of Vice-President for Professionals.

MERIT LIST RECOMMENDATIONS

The names of academic and professional HSC employees recommended to the Division of the Budget for discretionary increases has been released by the Office of Personnel. The list does not indicate the amounts of merit raises recommended for each individual and has not yet been approved by the Division of the Budget.

Distribution of discretionary monies is covered by Article 20.3(d) of our contract: "Such distribution shall occur on July 1, 1981, and shall be retroactive to July 1, 1980, or September 1, 1980, as appropriate to professional obligation or date of eligibility for salary increases."

Chapter treasurer Raymond Woznick was again elected to succeed himself. Ray has been the chapter's treasurer for eight years. Jeanne Galbraith, Acting Secretary since the resignation of Muriel Regan last October, was elected to a full term as chapter secretary.

Both grievance chairman were re-elected to their position. Leonard Andors is the Academic Grievance Chairman and Sheldon Scher won the Professional Grievance Chairman position over six write-in candidates.

The four professionals elected as representatives to the Delegate Assembly are Richard Blakeslee, Kathleen Cooper, Mary Dickinson and Dawn Hopkins. Barbara Kelly was elected as an alternate delegate. There were twenty three different write-in candidates for professional delegate positions.

Academics elected Jeanne Galbraith, Ora Bouey, Donald Cox and Henry Godfrey as delegates. Their alternate delegate choices were Patricia O'Neill and Marion Lewis.

"I would like to thank all of our members who showed an interest in the union by participating in the elective process," said President Hartnett. "With the election behind us, I would like to invite all members to become active in your union regardless of your preference for any candidate. There are many opportunities for participation such as being a department rep or a member of the legislative, newsletter or program committees and so forth. Your help and support will make our chapter a viable force to effect positive change in SUNY."

The HSC Chapter has grown by approximately 200 members during President Hartnett's term of office. Membership now numbers 540 persons.

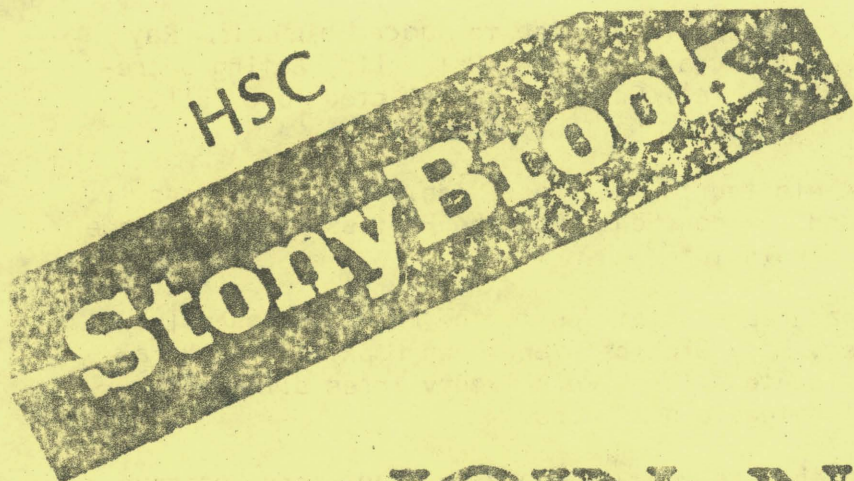
WHAT IS A FIELD REP?

Through its affiliation with New York State United Teachers (NYSUT), UUP receives the services of NYSUT staff members. Each campus chapter of UUP is assigned a specific field representative to act as a resource person for the chapter and its leadership.

Many of you know the HSC Chapter field rep, Richard Baron. Mr. Baron is also assigned to UUP chapters in Farmingdale, Old Westbury and on the main campus here at Stony Brook. He provides services and gives advice to the elected chapter leadership at each of his four campuses.

Here at the HSC, Mr. Baron has been helpful in developing our department representative structure. For example, this past March Mavis Stephenson and Sheldon Scher organized a departmental representatives workshop to be given by Mr. Baron and his colleagues. Mr. Baron also has been instrumental in recruiting new members and has been a valuable asset in preparing and advocating grievances with the appropriate grievance chairs on behalf of our members.

In the past there has been some confusion over the field rep's role in determining and implementing policy. The policy making process is not one of the functions of the field rep. This remains the province of the chapter president and executive board under the guidance and advice of the central UUP President and his Executive Board. All questions that deal with policy or interpretation of policy should be directed to the chapter leadership for review and implementation.
