AMENDMENT TO THE TEMPORARY SSC FUNDING ADJUSTMENT ACT

An Act to amend the temporary bill to correct miscommunication between USG and SSC-Funded Clubs

Be it enacted by the Senate of the Undergraduate Student Government,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE

This Act shall be referred to as the "Amendment to the Temporary SSC Funding Adjustment Act."

SECTION 2. FINDINGS

The Senate finds that -

- 1. The Temporary SSC Funding Adjustment Act was conceived and written to correct a major error in communication between USG and SSC clubs and organizations, while maintaining the integrity of the permanent legislation;
- 2. The temporary modification to the New Club Funding Act inadequately addressed the unique situation of SSC Clubs for this Spring 2012 Semester, despite the belief that it was the appropriate cure-all;
- 3. Some SSC Clubs will be adversely affected, with a deleterious effect on student life, if a modification is not made; and
- 4. The Undergraduate Student Government should not punish student clubs for augmenting their duly-appropriated moneys.

SECTION 3. DEFINITIONS

REVENUE – The term "Revenue" shall refer solely to monies raised, encompassing monies earned, exclusive of the Student Activity Fee allocated by the Undergraduate Student Government. This shall not be construed to mean that monies raised through use of the Student Activity Fee, once the initial investment has been repaid, are not encompassed in this definition.

SECTION 4. STATEMENT OF LEGISLATIVE INTENT

Without the approval of this legislation, some SSC-Funded Organizations would be eligible to apply to request negative amounts. This Act is an attempt to do right by the Clubs and not punish them for any enterprising actions.

SECTION 5. AMENDMENT

The inserted line of section 3 of the Temporary SSC Funding Adjustment Act shall read the following:

- 3. SSC Clubs that raised revenue shall be eligible to apply for funding in the Spring based on the earlier temporary legislation or the following algorithm:
 - \$1750 Expenditures + Revenue
 - a. A Club that has already submitted its funding request for the Spring 2012 Semester prior to the enactment of this legislation shall have the right to submit one modification request if this amendment would benefit it.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Act shall take effect immediately following the enactment of this Act and shall expire on May 4th, 2012.
