## **UUP SEEKING NOMINEES FOR COLLEGE COMMITTEES**

At the 10/19 UUP mtg election for college committee will take place. The two are College Committee on Professional Evaluation and the College Review Panel. If you are interested in serving on these committee contact Chapter President John Schmidt @ 2-6570 John.Schmidt@sunysb.edu . College Committee on Professional Evaluation (CCPE)

The Committee shall consist of three (3) professional employees serving in positions in the negotiating unit at each college, elected at large by all the professional employees in the negotiating unit at the college.

- a) The CCPE shall, upon the timely request of a professional employee, review a final evaluation characterized as "unsatisfactory".
- b) Committee review shall address both the procedures and substance of the unsatisfactory evaluation. College Review Panel (CRP)

Professional employees shall elect a College Review Panel. such panel shall consist of not less than five (5) nor more than seven (7) members elected at large by all professional employees in the negotiating unit. The Panel shall:

- 1) review applications for promotions and make decisions and recommendations with respect to such applications in accordance with appropriate provisions of the contract.
- 2) review applications for salary increases resulting from a permanent and significant increase in duties and responsibilities which are not accompanied by a change in title or rank.
