March 23th is the Triangle Shirtwaist Fire UUP event on Campus

This week marks the 100th anniversary of the Tragic Fire in New York City that cost the lives of 146 Triangle Shirtwaist Factory employees. Your UUP chapter will be holding an event this Wednesday the 23rd at 3 to 5pm to mark this horrific event that led to public outcry against unsafe working conditions. Even politicians reacted to this great loss of mostly immigrant girls by enacting labor laws to help protect workers. The place will be the Wang Center Chapel and all members of our campus community are invited. It should be noted over 120,000 persons turned out for the 1911 funeral procession in New York City after a citywide day of mourning was called for by organized labor. Those innocent children, young women, and men, mostly immigrants, paid the ultimate price. We all owe them a debt of gratitude, and I hope you can join us at on the 23rd to reflect on this nation and union labor changing event.
