**Per Campus Police, we are distributing the following from Kathleen Horan :**

At around 10AM, a female student was approached in the 3rd core west by a male, early 20's. He attempted to make conversation, then asked the female student: "What are the odds that you would have sex with me? Slim to none?" She replied, "none," and he walked away. The female student was very upset. We reported the incident to the police, and a few minutes later, the male returned, having forgotten his backpack in the stacks, apparently. He was not apprehended, but campus police have a description of him.

The male was wearing dark blue cut-off shorts (below the knee), a medium grey t-shirt, dk. blue or black sneakers with no socks, and had a duffel-type black canvas backpack.
