

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

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

Introduction

Information relating to age is one of the most sought after items from census records. The data is needed by social service, educational, youth and senior citizen agencies to provide current services and plan for future facilities. This report presents age material emanating from 1970 and 1980 census tapes and 1960 printed data. The tables present summaries of the data that should be useful to a wide group of people.

Comparison to National Data

The population on Long Island has long been viewed as youth oriented. Young families with large amounts of young children comprised a major portion of the population in the postwar period when Nassau and Suffolk Counties were among the fastest growing in the nation. The past decade has been one of maturation where the population has aged and now has an age profile similar to certain cities and older suburbs.

The following table indicates existing and projected proportions of the national population that is represented by children and young adults:

The youth population at the national level which includes pre-schoolers, elementary and junior high students has declined sharply since 1960 and is expected to maintain the same proportion of the population at the turn of the century. High school students and young adults have reached a national peak

in 1980 and are expected to decline to 1960 levels. The following table shows the Long Island proportions of the young population from 1960 through 1980.

In 1960 and 1970 there was a difference of more than four percent between the local proportions and the national numbers. Long Island had a greater proportion in the youth category and less in the high school and young adult groups. By 1980 the differences had narrowed to the 1 to 2 percent range. Based on present trends, the youth population could slip below national proportions while the young adults may follow the same pattern as the national figures.

Elderly population on Long Island in the past few decades has been below national averages. The current figures and projections make local and national figures much closer.

Age Group Change

The comparison of percentages of population by age group over the last twenty years illustrates the aging of the bi-county population. Pre-school children accounted from almost 12% of the population in 1960. The 1980 figure has been reduced to only 6%. At the other end of the scale is the over 55 group which accounted for 14.5% of the 1960 population and now has moved up to 20.5% of the current total. The high school and college age population that falls between the ages of 15 and 24 now accounts for 8% more of the overall population than was reflected in the 1960 figures. The middle group, between 25 and 54, has shown a proportional change from 42.5% down to 39.3%. Table 3 indicates the changes in population for the major municipalities in each county.

Twenty years ago the pre-school population represented the largest five year component of the population in each county. Suffolk County had a larger percent in this group than Nassau. However, the Nassau elementary and junior high age groups represented a larger percent than similar categories in Suffolk County. By 1970 all of the percentages for the previous groups were represented by higher numbers in Suffolk. The 1980 figures show a continued decline in Nassau County and even a faster decline in Suffolk County.

The senior citizen population (65 and over) represented 7% of the Suffolk County population twenty years ago, while Nassau County had over 6%. Now Nassau County has a senior citizen population that accounts for 10% of the total while the Suffolk proportion has only increased to 9%.

Pre-school population accounted for more than 13% of all the 1960 population cohorts in the Towns of Oyster Bay, Babylon, Huntington, Islip, Smithtown and Brookhaven. Now only Brookhaven Town has more than 8% accorded to this group and only three other towns are over 6%.

Senior citizen population as a proportion of all population has increased in almost all of the towns and cities in the last twenty years. The exceptions are Smithtown and Islip Towns which include state psychiatric hospitals within their borders. These hospitals have always had large amounts of elderly and there have been sharp declines in population in all large institutions of this type. The Town of Shelter Island which had 19% of the 1960 population in a senior citizen category now has 30% in that group. Southold Town has gone from under 15% to over 23% and the City of Long Beach went from over 11% to over 21%. Islip and Oyster Bay Towns have approximately 8% of the total population in the over 65 group which puts them at the lowest level among major municipalities. Even though Oyster Bay Town is in this low group, the change still reflects a doubling over the twenty year period. On the other hand the current Islip figure represents a 2% reduction because of the aforementioned loss of elderly population in the two state psychiatric hospitals within the town. The Town of Brookhaven which has a large proportion of young children also has more than 8% in the senior citizen category. This is because the town has a large number of converted seasonal units that are occupied by the retired and the town also houses the largest retirement development on the Island.

Appendix Table A provides age group and median age data for all cities, villages and census designated places.

Median Age

The median age in the Nassau-Suffolk SMSA, after registering a decline between 1960 and 1970 of 2.1 years, has now increased 3.5 years to 31.9. This means that this region is now in a group of sunbelt and older northeastern cities with the highest median age. There are 37 metropolitan areas of over 1 million population and only 8 have a median age higher than Long Island. Three are in Florida, one in California and the rest in the Middle Atlantic States.

The Nassau County median age increased slightly between 1960 and 1970, while Suffolk was going down by 3.6. Ten years later Nassau and Suffolk had increases of 3.3 and 3.5 respectively. Between 1960 and 1970 one-half dozen towns showed decreases in median age. The Towns of Islip, Smithtown and Brookhaven became 4-5 years younger. The 1980 data shows that all major municipalities with the exception of the City of Long Beach now have older populations than 10 years ago. The Long Beach area has always had a large elderly population and it has now been supplemented by younger families living in multiple units and converted seasonal units. Table 4 indicates the median age of the major municipalities in 1960, 1970 and 1980. Appendix Table A has the 1980 median for all villages and census designated places. Map 1 shows the 1980 median age in six categories.

The State Psychiatric Centers in Brentwood, Central Islip and Kings Park continue to have the oldest population of any of the statistical areas on Long Island. The median age is over 65 for all three which accounts for the continuing rapid decline in total population in all of the institutions.

Most of the communities with exceptionally high median ages are located in the east end. The community of Shelter Island Heights and the Village of Derby Harbor with a median age of 59.5 and 58.3 respectively head the list. Both are located on Shelter Island. The Napeague-Hither Hills area and the Village of North Haven also have median ages over 50. Orient-East Marion, Calverton-Roanoke, Greenport West and Southold have medians of 49.8, 48.1, 47.5 and 47.4. Two adjoining Nassau County villages, North Hills with 48.0 and Lake Success with 46.8 are also in the group of 10 with the oldest median ages.

The areas with college dormitories such as East Farmingdale, East Garden City, Brookville and Stony Brook have median ages in the low 20's. The Poospatuck Indian Reservation is also in the young group. The next youngest group are communities with minority population. North Bellport at 21.8, Wyandanch at 23.8, North Great River at 25.0 and Roosevelt at 25.4 are examples. The remainder of the young communities are Shirley, Centereach and Selden which are predominantly white areas with recently built single family housing.

There are only a handful of communities that experienced a reduction in median age in the past decade. The overall aging of the region is reflected in the small increases registered in most older communities and the very significant increases in newer communities. Even predominantly non-white areas which historically have had very young populations have either remained the same or increased modestly in the last decade.

The trend exceptions are the old Villages of Sea Cliff and East Williston which recorded median age reductions of 1.8 and 2.5 and Mastic Beach which had a 5.1 reduction. The two villages had older populations at an early date and are now experiencing some turnover of older houses. Mastic Beach was long a retirement area where former seasonal residents converted small houses for such use. The low cost of obtaining either the remaining seasonal units or vacated conversions has been an attraction for young families.

The largest jumps in median age occurred in newer communities. Old Bethpage moved up 9.3 from 23.1, Jericho increased 8.1 and the Village of Lloyd Harbor increased 8.1. The increasing cost of housing which precludes families with young children is an explanation for the change. Slightly smaller increases were found in Plainview (7.8), South Westbury (7.5), Massapequa Park (7.3), North Wantagh (7.2), East Massapequa (6.9), Locust Grove (6.9) and South Farmingdale (6.5). All of these areas are middle to upper middle class. Newer communities such as Bohemia have increased by 6.4 because of the existence of mobile home communities that are attractive to the elderly. Even the formerly young community of Levittown has had a median age increase from 24.0 to 30.3.

Communities that were mainly developed in the World War II period and earlier showed limited change, now have a slightly younger population. The Villages of Cedarhurst, Lawrence, Malverne, Rockville Centre, Great Neck, Mineola, Roslyn, Amityville, and Babylon are examples of areas that aged in earlier census periods and now experience turnover to new families. Unincorporated communities like Elmont, West Hempstead, North New Hyde Park, Oyster Bay and Bay Shore could also be included. Appendix Table B ranks all places according to median age.

Pre-School Population

The number of children of pre-school age is a good indicator of short-term elementary school enrollment patterns. The extensive amount of school openings and closings on Long Island in the past 20 years reflects the very rapid change in the pre-school population. Overall, the region lost 75,000 persons in the 0-4 category between 1960 and 1980. However, the loss was entirely in Nassau County. Suffolk County had 87,689 pre-schoolers in 1960, increased to 112,093 in 1970, and declined back to 87,392 in 1980. Table 5 summarizes the pre-school changes for the counties and major municipalities.

There has been some very fast turnarounds in pre-school population in some of the towns and cities. Between 1960 and 1970, the Town of Smithtown had a 76% gain. The following decade the town showed a 47% loss. The 1960 and 1980 totals are similar while the 1970 figure represented a peak that was almost double the other 2 years. A majority of the elementary schools in the town were built during the sixties to accommodate the peak. The Town of Islip also experienced a turnaround of smaller percentage but of greater magnitude.

The only large town that has shown a continual gain in the past two decades is Brookhaven. In 1980, the ten-year gain was less than 10%. Decreases over 30% in each decade were recorded in the Town of Oyster Bay and City of Glen Cove. Hempstead Town now has only half of the eighty thousand pre-school children recorded in 1960.

School Age Population

School age population (5 through 17) increased sharply in the region between 1960 and 1970. The next decade recorded a reversal of 20% and short range projections indicate the school-age total will soon be below the 1960 figure. The pre-school population had a net loss in the region at the end of the 60's decade and the 70's decade reflecting the decline in birth rates that began in the late fifties. The school-age population growth in the sixties was a result of the record birth rates and immigration in the previous decade.

Nassau County presently has a school-age population that is 125,000 less than the almost 400,000 recorded in the 1970 Census. The current Suffolk County figure is only 15,000 below the 1970 peak. Another difference between the counties is that school-age population now represents only 20% of the Nassau population while in the previous 2 censuses it was close to 28%. Suffolk County school age population now accounts for a quarter of the population which is the same proportion as was recorded in 1960. The school-age population had reached 30% in 1970.

In the decade ending in 1970 only the Town of Shelter Island lost school-age population. See Table 6 which shows the change in persons 5-17 in the major municipalities. The Towns of Hempstead and North Hempstead had single digit percentage growth but all others had much larger increases with Smithtown recording an increase of over 240%. The Towns of Islip and Brookhaven had the largest numerical increases of over 40,000.

The 1970-80 period found the small Town of Shelter Island and the large Town of Brookhaven with the only school age increases. The largest percentage loss was in the Town of Oyster Bay and Hempstead Town had the largest numerical loss. Between these two towns, there was a total loss of over 100,000 children in the 5 through 17 age group. The two most western Suffolk Towns, Babylon and Huntington, each lost more than 13,000 school-age children. Together they had gained over 50 thousand a decade earlier.

Senior Citizen Population

The regional population over 65 has almost doubled in the period between 1960 and 1980. There are now more than one-quarter million senior citizens in this area. Even though the total growth of Nassau and Suffolk Counties was different, there has been a net gain of 60,000 seniors in each county.

The twenty-year growth in major municipalities has resulted in a tripling of the 65 and over population in Brookhaven and Riverhead Towns, an increase of two and one-half in the Hamptons and doubling in the Towns of Huntington, Smithtown, Shelter Island, Southold and Oyster Bay, plus the City of Long Beach. Table 7 shows the absolute and percentage change for persons 65 years and over.

The 1960-70 decade showed the largest percentage increases for senior citizens in the City of Long Beach and the Towns of Riverhead, Brookhaven and Southampton. The Towns of Brookhaven and Riverhead again had the highest percentage gains in the next decade. The Towns of Hempstead and Brookhaven had the largest numerical gain in both decades; however, Hempstead had twice as much growth as Brookhaven between 1960 and 1970, while the decade ending in 1980 showed a growth that was almost equal.

The 1980 Census recorded one community with more than 5,000 senior citizens - the City of Long Beach. Appendix Table C ranks all communities, including the two cities, according to the number of persons 65 and over. Most of the places on the top of the list are either older villages such as Valley Stream, Hempstead, Rockville Centre, Freeport, Garden City, Lynbrook, Mineola and Floral Park, plus the City of Glen Cove or large communities that developed in the early postwar period, such as Franklin Square, Hicksville, Levittown, Elmont, West Babylon, Baldwin, Oceanside, East Meadow, Uniondale, Huntington Station, North New Hyde Park and Huntington. A few newer communities are in

the top 25, such as Lake Ronkonkoma, Smithtown and Ridge, the latter the site of Leisure Village.

Another way to view the 1980 senior citizen population at the community level is to rank the communities by percent of elderly. One-hundred fifty-six of the 283 communities have an over 65 population in excess of the regional figure of 9.83%. This data is shown on Map 2 at the rear of the report and on Appendix Table D. The three State Psychiatric Centers are at the top of the list, followed mainly by communities in the 5 eastern towns of Suffolk County, which reflects the retirement population in that area. East end communities account for 33 of the 50 communities with the highest percent of senior citizens. Most of the remaining 17 include 4 hospitals, communities with a large number of apartments such as Long Beach and Great Neck Plaza, communities with some type of senior citizen housing (Ridge, Manhasset, Woodbury, Amityville and North New Hyde Park) and communities with seasonal housing converted to year-round use such as Ocean Beach and Rocky Point.

Marital Status

The proportion of 15 and over population that is married has dropped in the last ten years from two-thirds of the 1970 population to just under 60%. The separated and widowed population currently have similar percentages of the total population as existed in 1970. Major gains are in the single and divorced category. Persons recorded as single increased by almost 150,000. They represented 23.6% of the 15 and over population in 1970 and in 1980 account for 27.7% of the total. Divorced people increased by 175% in the ten year period. They comprised only 1.5% of the total ten years ago and in 1980 they account for 3.5%.

The percent of persons separated, widowed and divorced increased from 10% to 13% of the population in the last decade. However, the proportion that is female increased greatly so that there are even wider differences between males and females. In 1970 2.3% of the males were in this category compared to 7.9% of the females. The 1980 proportions are 3.2% and 9.7%. Tables 8 and 9 show the regional, county and major municipality changes in marital status.

The 1980 statistics show a greater variation in the proportion of single and married people in the major municipalities than existed in 1970. Different portions of the region are becoming more retirement oriented, while others are accommodating singles. In 1970 the Towns of Oyster Bay and Hempstead had the highest proportion of singles due to the large amount of high school and college students still living at home in the areas of maximum postwar growth. In 1980 the City of Glen Cove and the Town of Babylon had the highest proportions of singles since rental housing for young adults who wish to live separately is available in both municipalities.

The Towns of Brookhaven and Smithtown had the highest proportions of married population in 1970 which reflected large scale single family housing development at that time. Ten years later Brookhaven is still in the top three but is exceeded by the Towns of Shelter Island and Southold which are attracting retirement couples.

The City of Long Beach was in the upper proportions of the widowed, divorced and separated categories in 1970 and has the highest proportions in all three categories in 1980. The retirement oriented towns of Shelter Island, Southampton and East Hampton are also high in these categories.
