JOB DESCRIPTION

Stony Brook University Seawolves Mascot – “Wolfie”

The Stony Brook Athletic Department is currently seeking part-time, seasonal mascots. This position reports directly to the Manager of Marketing and Corporate Sales and Coordinator of Merchandise and Branding and is responsible for but not limited to the following:

- Performing at all home football, men’s and women’s basketball, and men’s lacrosse games during the 2010-11 season.
- Performing at birthday parties, parades, festivals, campus events, etc on specified days during the week and on weekends throughout the year.
- Performing at off-site community appearances.
- Meet and greet fans prior to and after the game.
- Participate in pre-game and in-game promotions, including contests, photo ops, t-shirt toss, etc.
- Creating skits, dance routines, and other forms of mascot-related entertainment and crowd interaction- Perform choreographed cheer/dance routines with the SB Dance Team and Cheerleaders
- Responsible for researching, creating and/or purchasing props and costumes for the mascot.
- Responsible for mascot costume operations including creativity, care, cleaning, maintenance, etc.

Requirements:

- Some experience is preferred but not required.
- Due to costume restrictions, to play the role of Wolfie, candidate must be at least 5 feet 9 inches and no more than 6 feet 1 inch.
- Must be well organized and flexible to meet time, priority and workload demands.
- Ability to analyze and interpret common social expressions and clients needs or wants relating to the mascot.
- Punctuality is mandatory and available to work flexible hours including all home games, some nights and weekends (Must arrive one (1) hour prior to game time, in costume 1/2 hour prior to game start).
- Own transportation is preferred.
- Must be highly energetic and in good physical condition.
- Fan friendly and outgoing individual.
- Works well with children and other staff members at any events.
- Must be able to work in a costume.
